



Bird Relay

Purpose: To familiarize the pathfinder with bird images so they may be able to go out and identify 30 species of wild birds that they have personally identified by sight out of doors. This is one of the requirements of the bird honor.

Equipment: Pictures of twenty-five birds and names of twenty-five birds (supplied by conference).

Team: Six to ten pathfinders.

Procedure: At the signal to start, the first pathfinder will run to the board and draw a name of a bird out of a bucket, they will then place the name under the appropriate picture. The team will continue in this order until all birds have been identified. The judge will then check the matches for accuracy and give the pathfinders the appropriate grade.

First Place: Correctly identify 21 to 25 birds.

Second Place: Correctly identify 16 to 20 birds.

Third Place: Correctly identify 1 to 15 birds.
